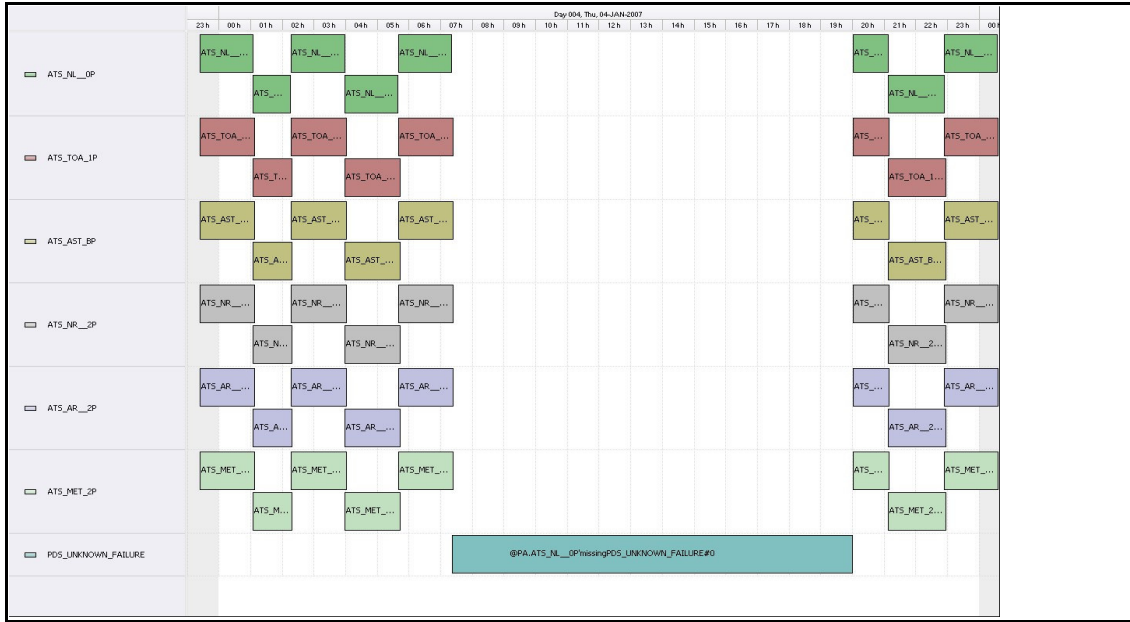

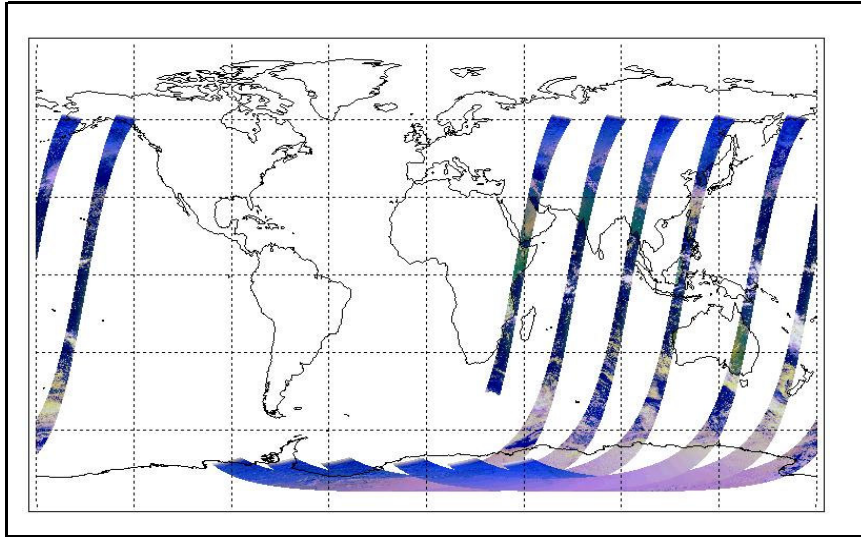

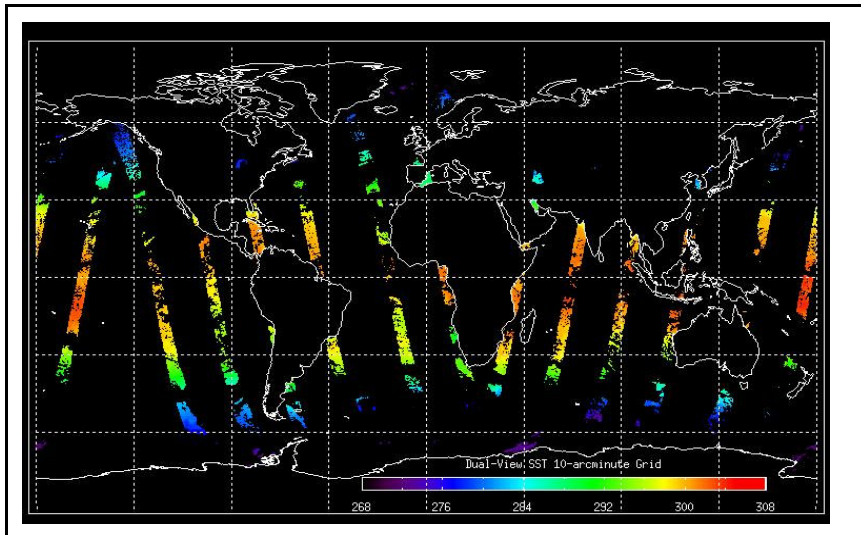
Map of browse products for: 04-Jan-07
