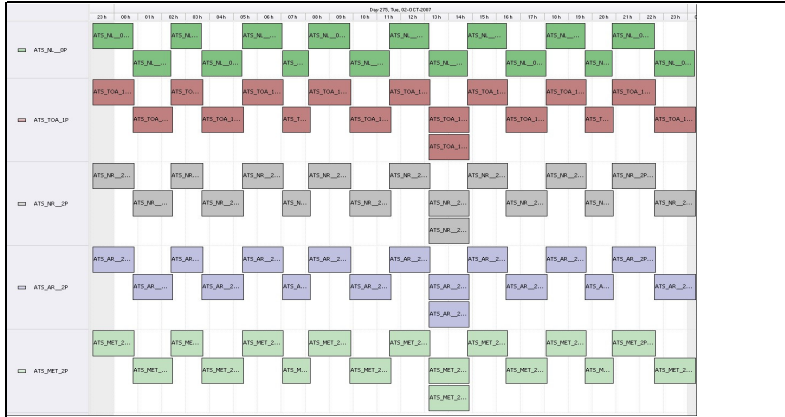

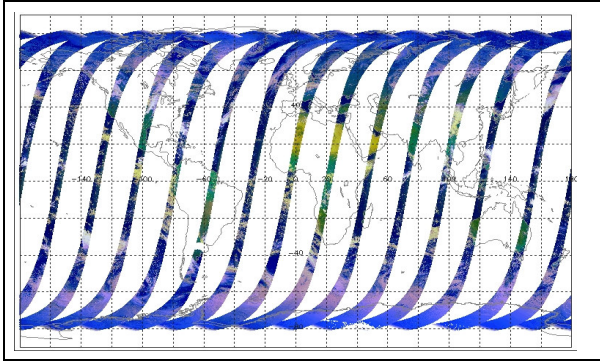

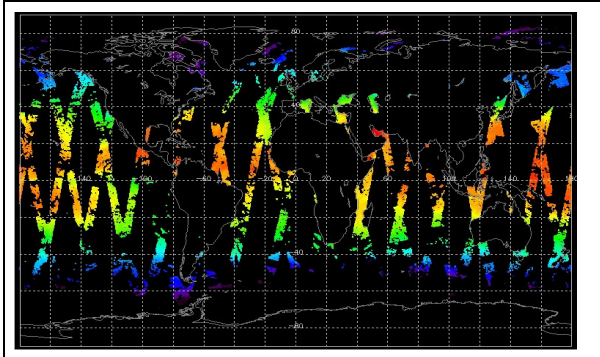
Map of browse products for: 02-Oct-07
