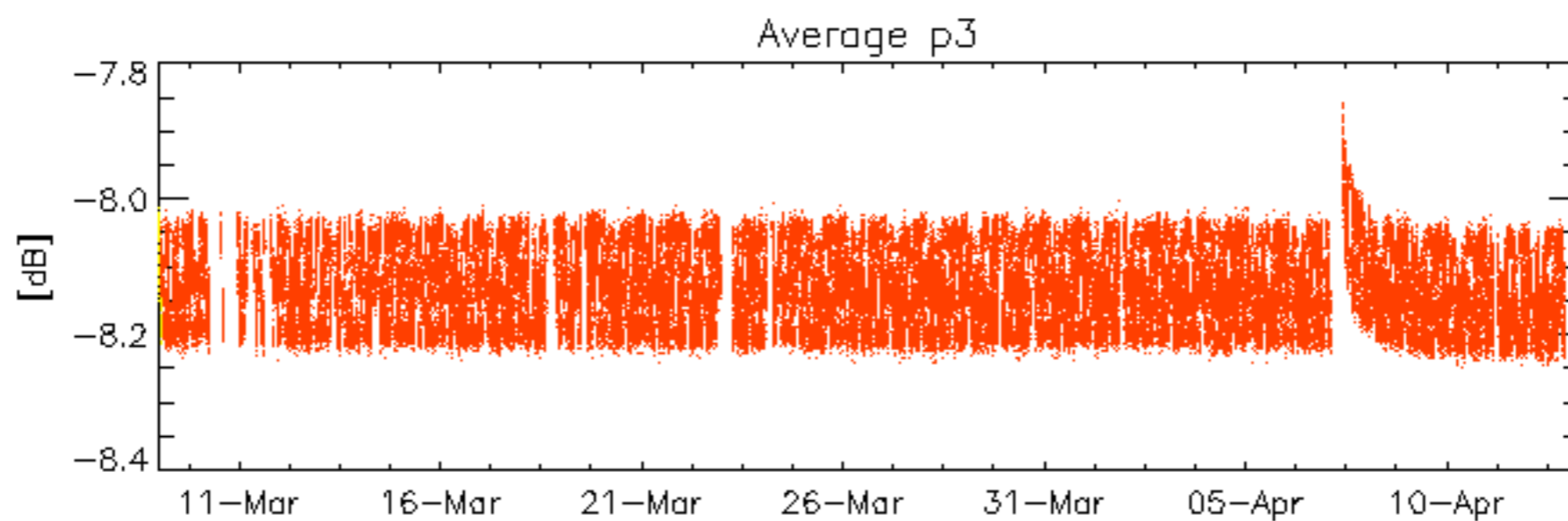
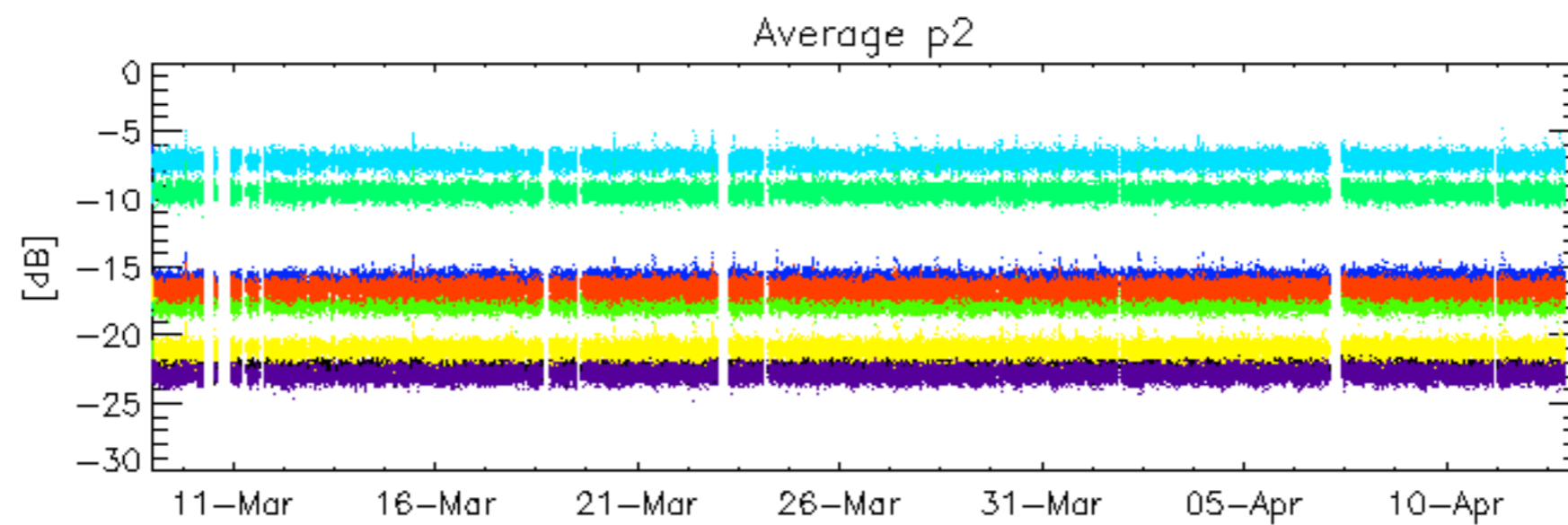
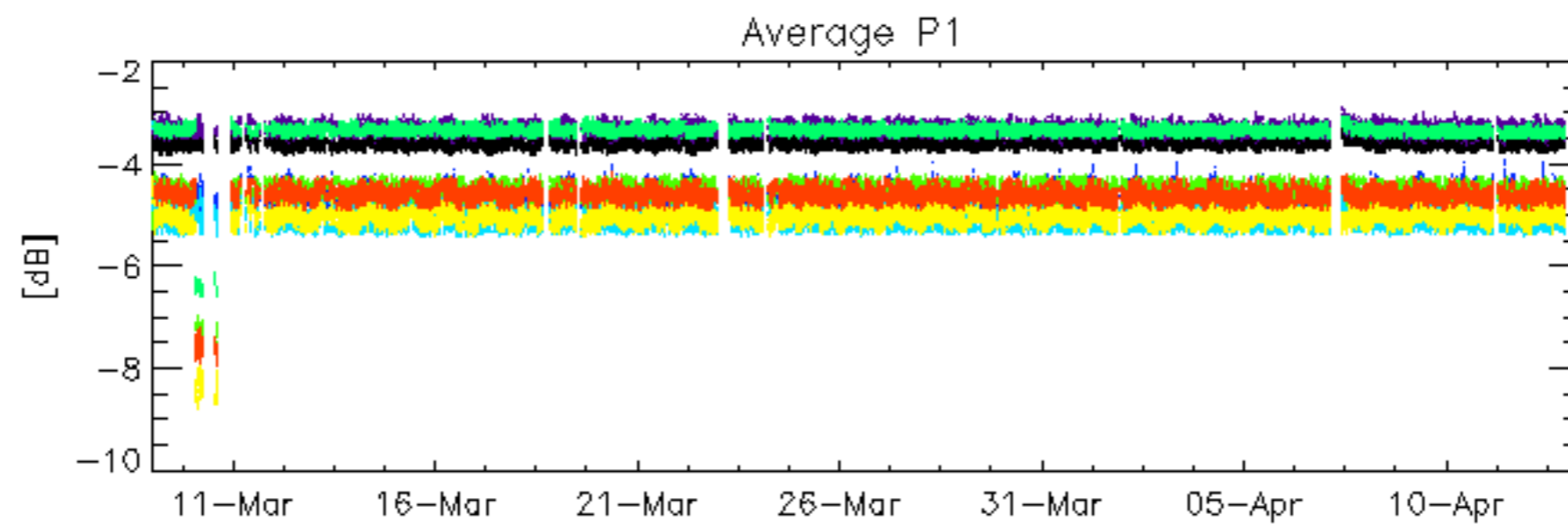

Evolution Doppler error versus ANX

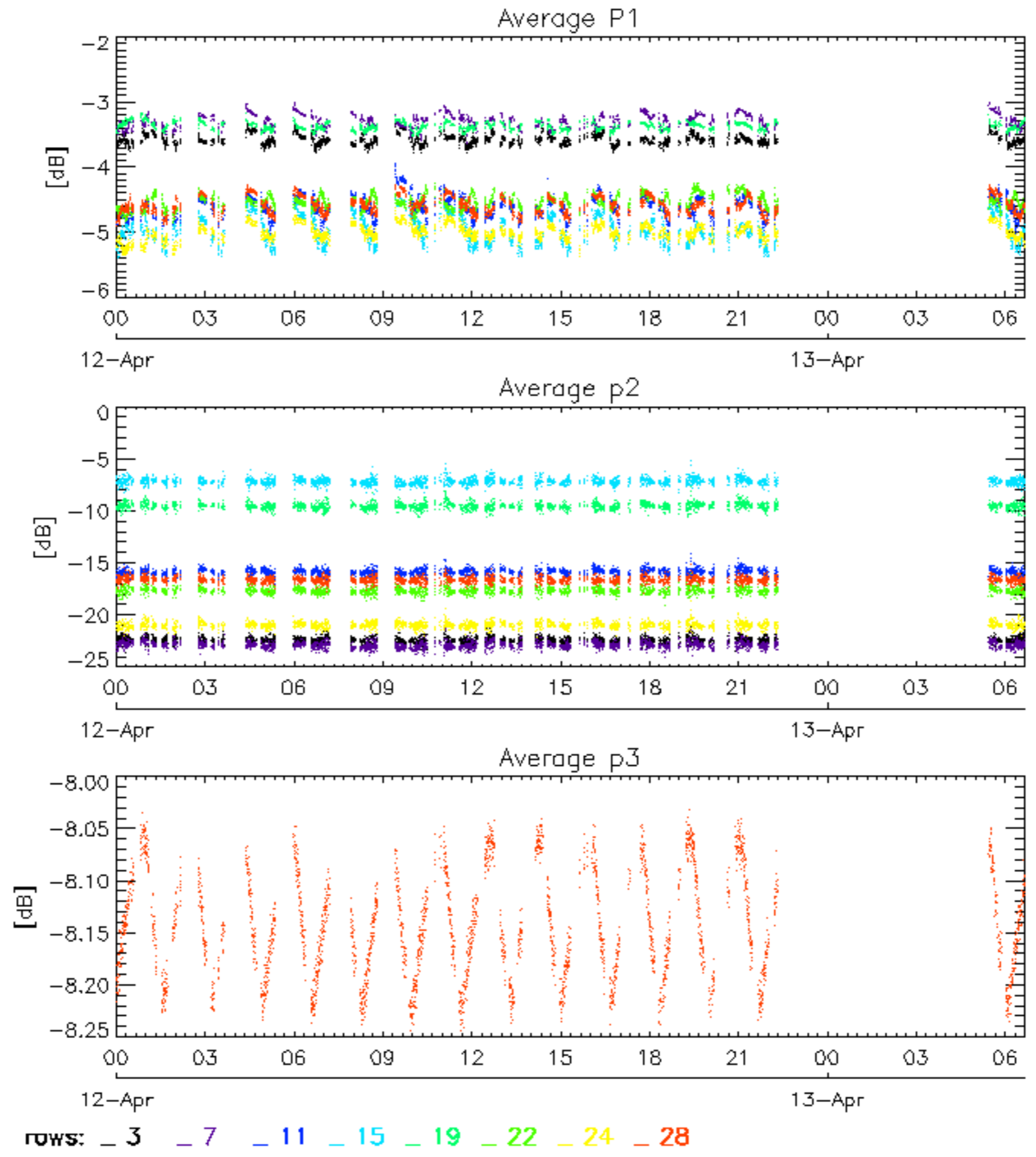


Evolution Doppler error versus ANX



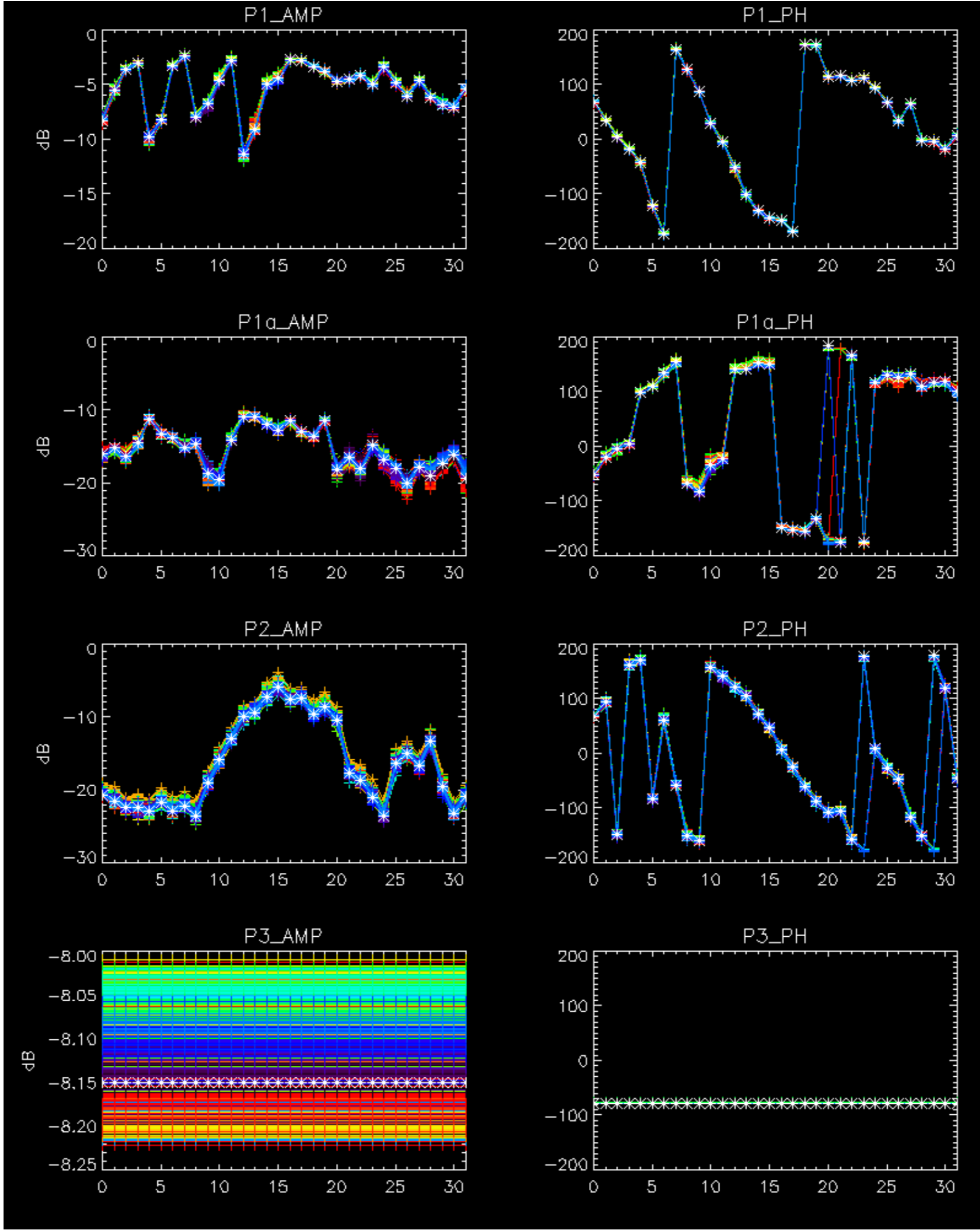

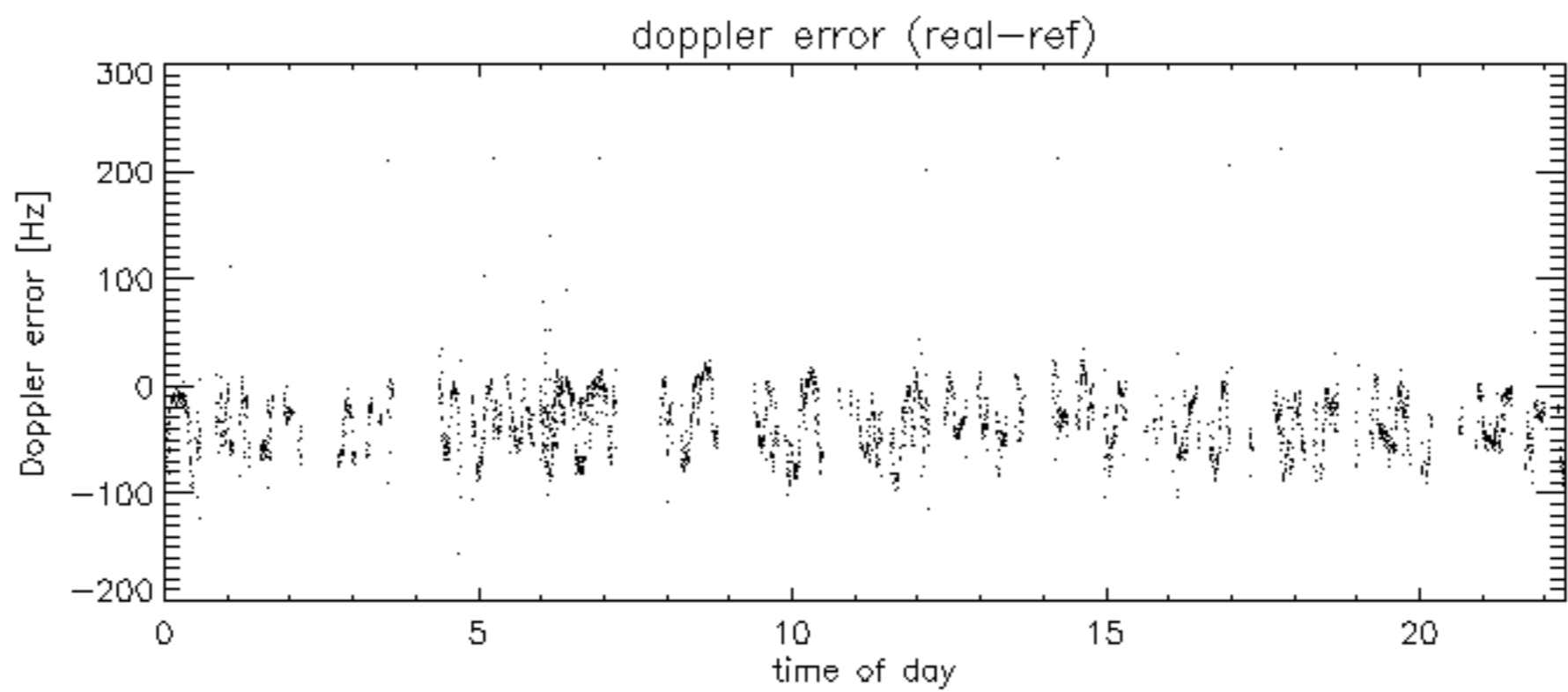
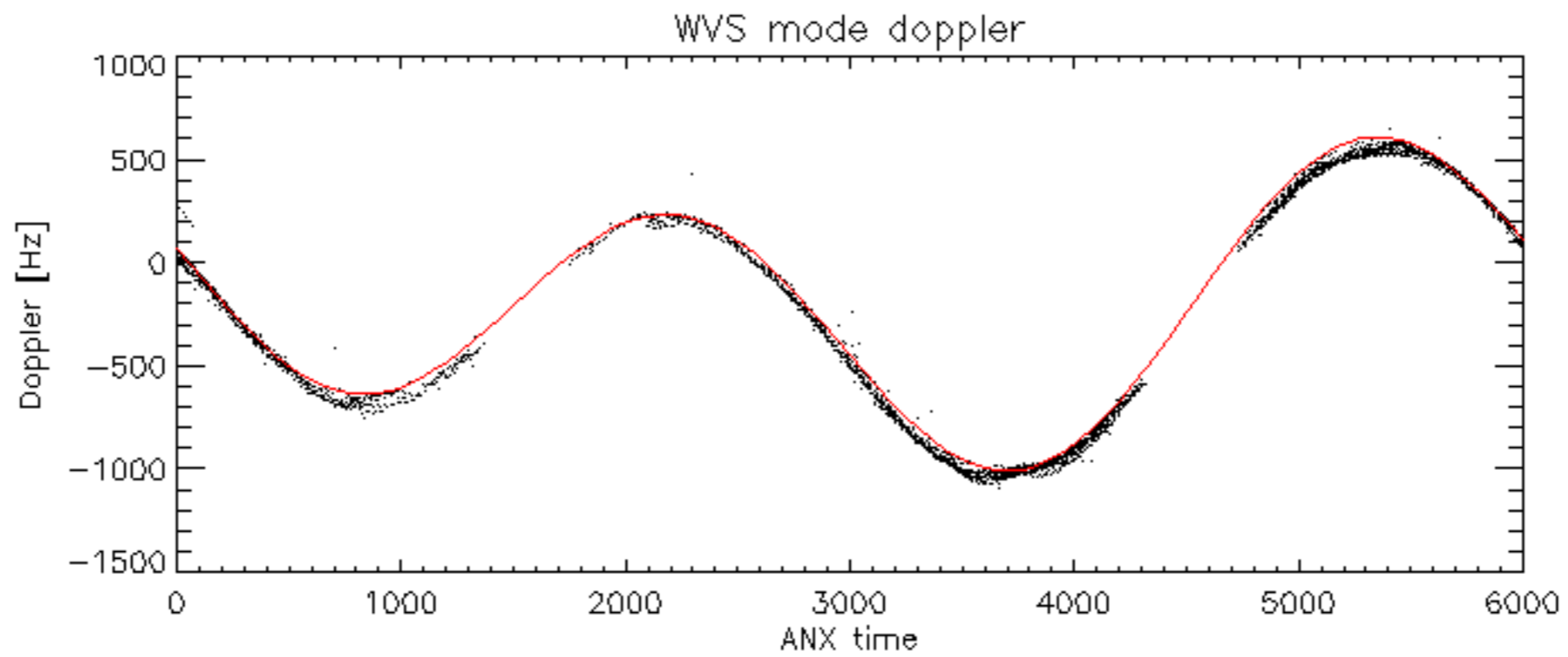
Doppler 'WVS' 'IS2' 'H/H'



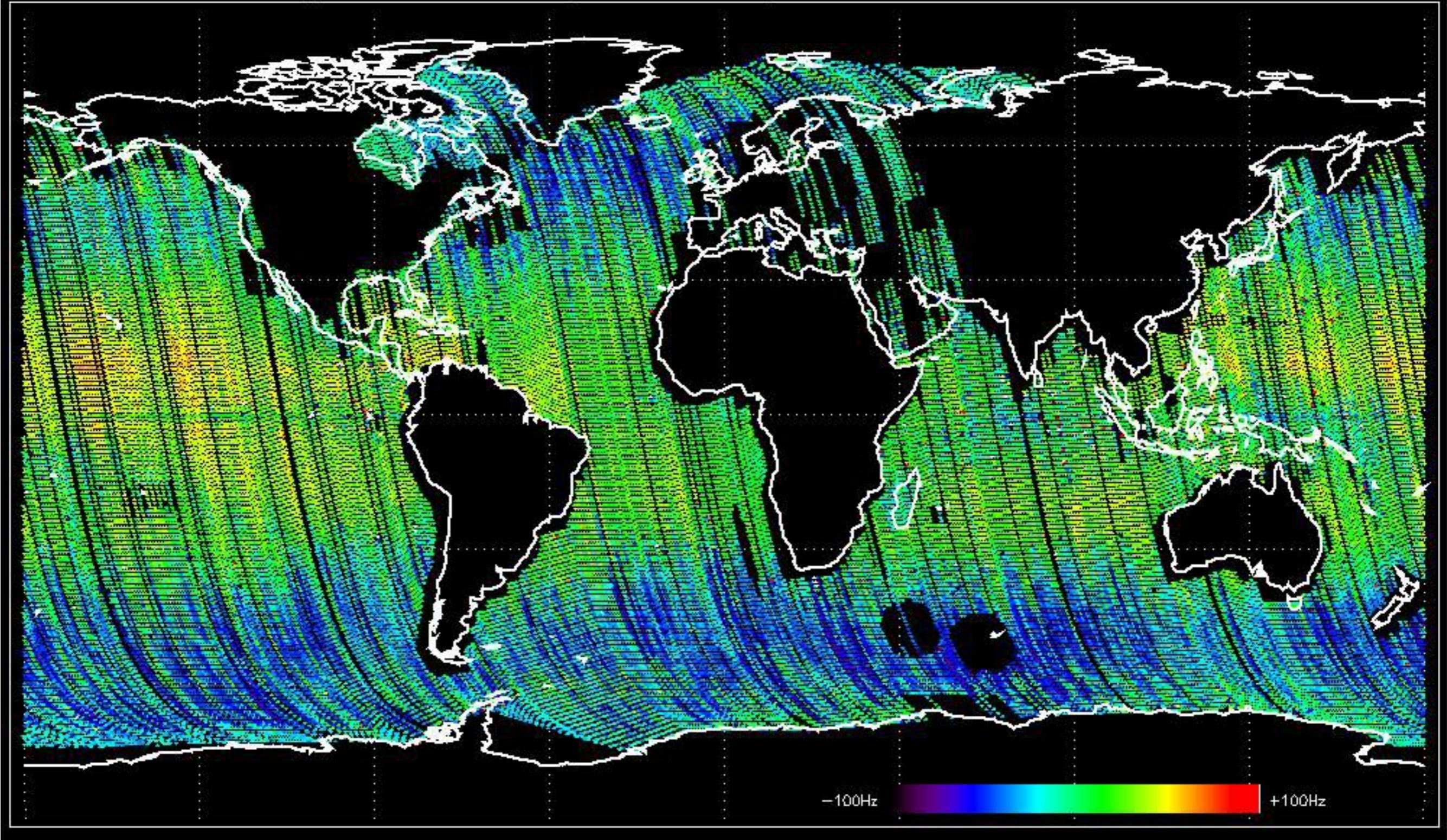
Doppler 'WVS' 'IS2' 'V/V'



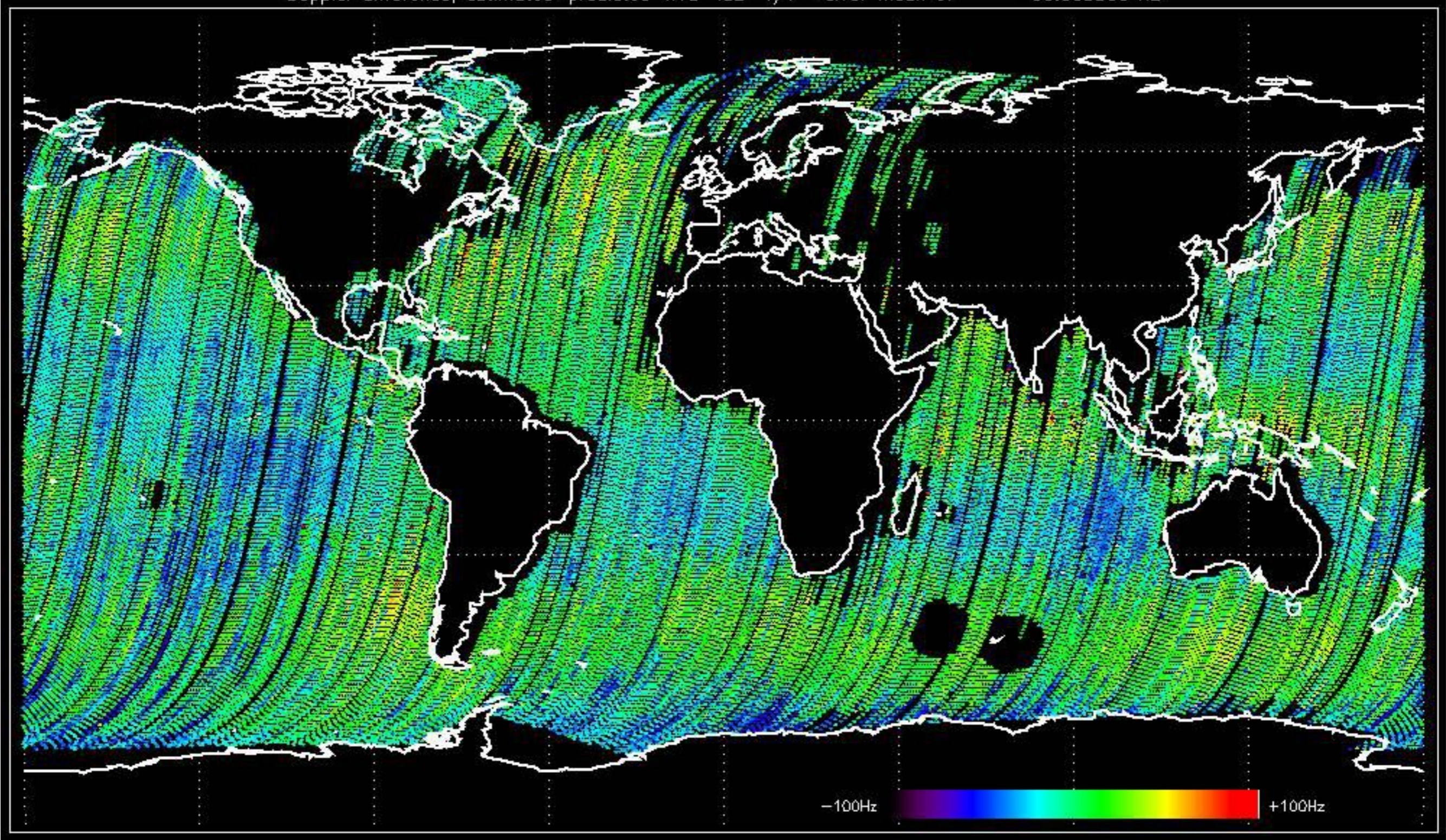




Doppler difference, estimated-predicted 'WVS' 'IS2' 'H/H' -error mean of -33.954191 Hz

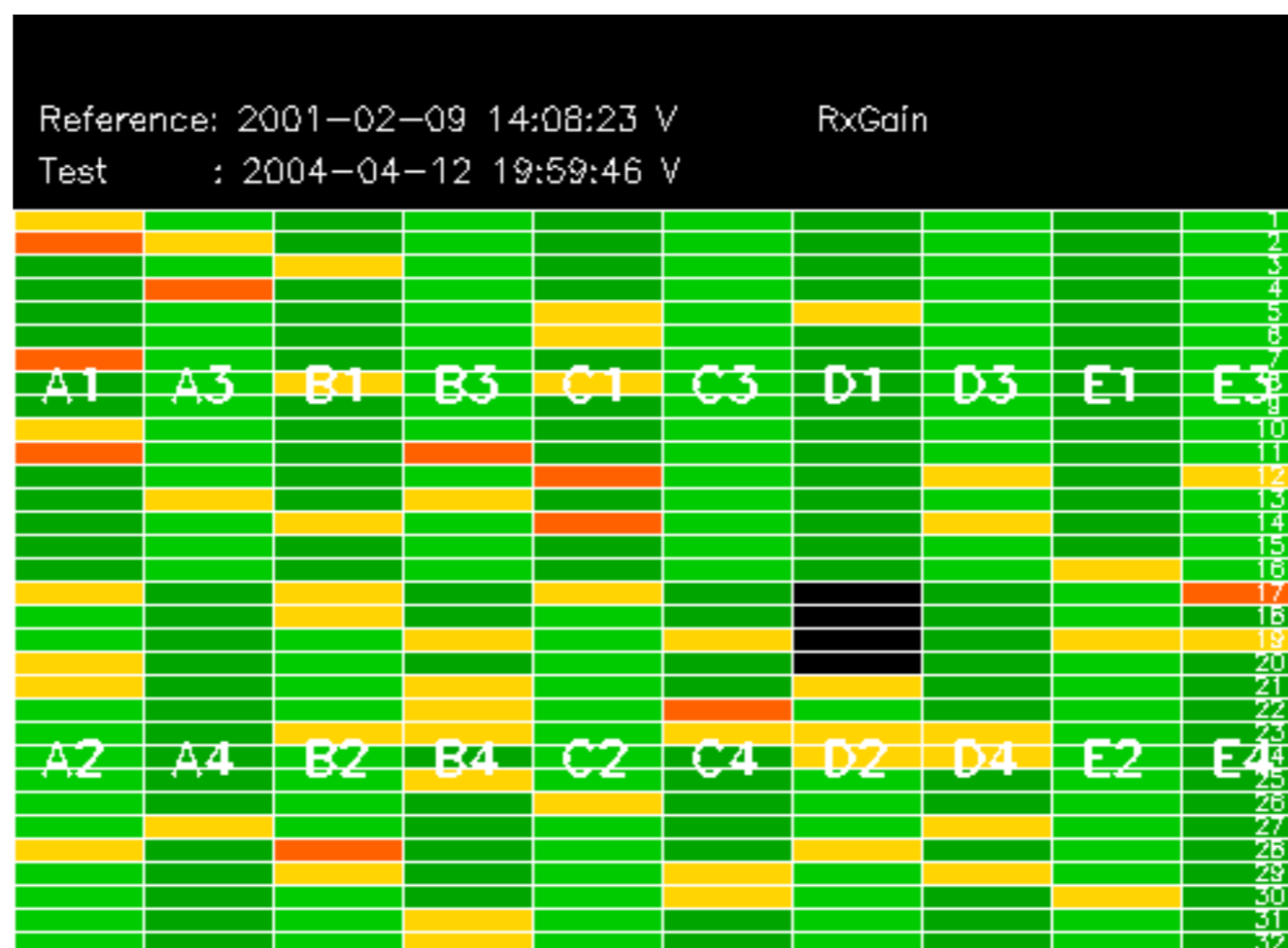


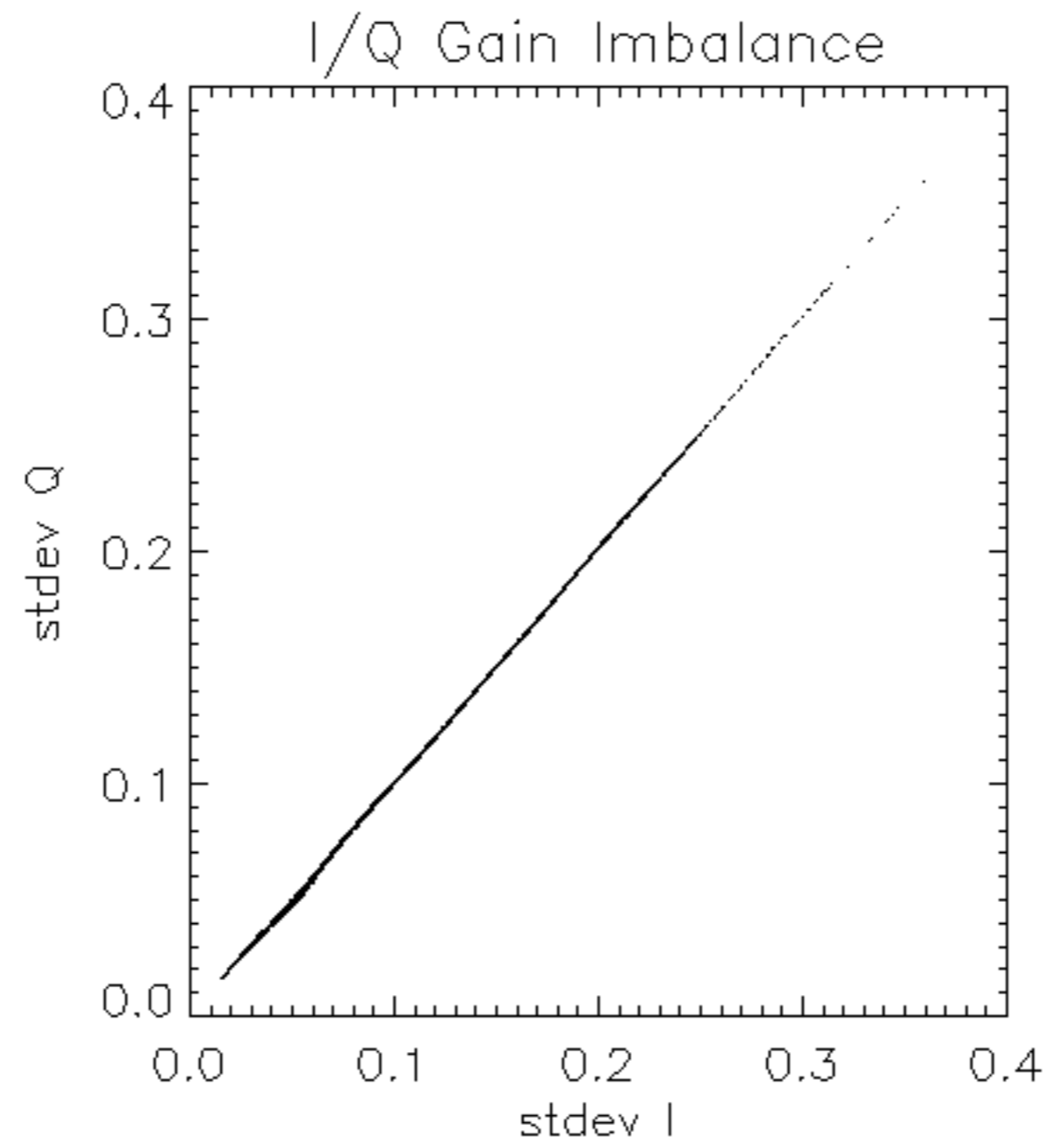
Doppler difference, estimated-predicted 'WVS' 'IS2' 'V/V' -error mean of -30.605866 Hz

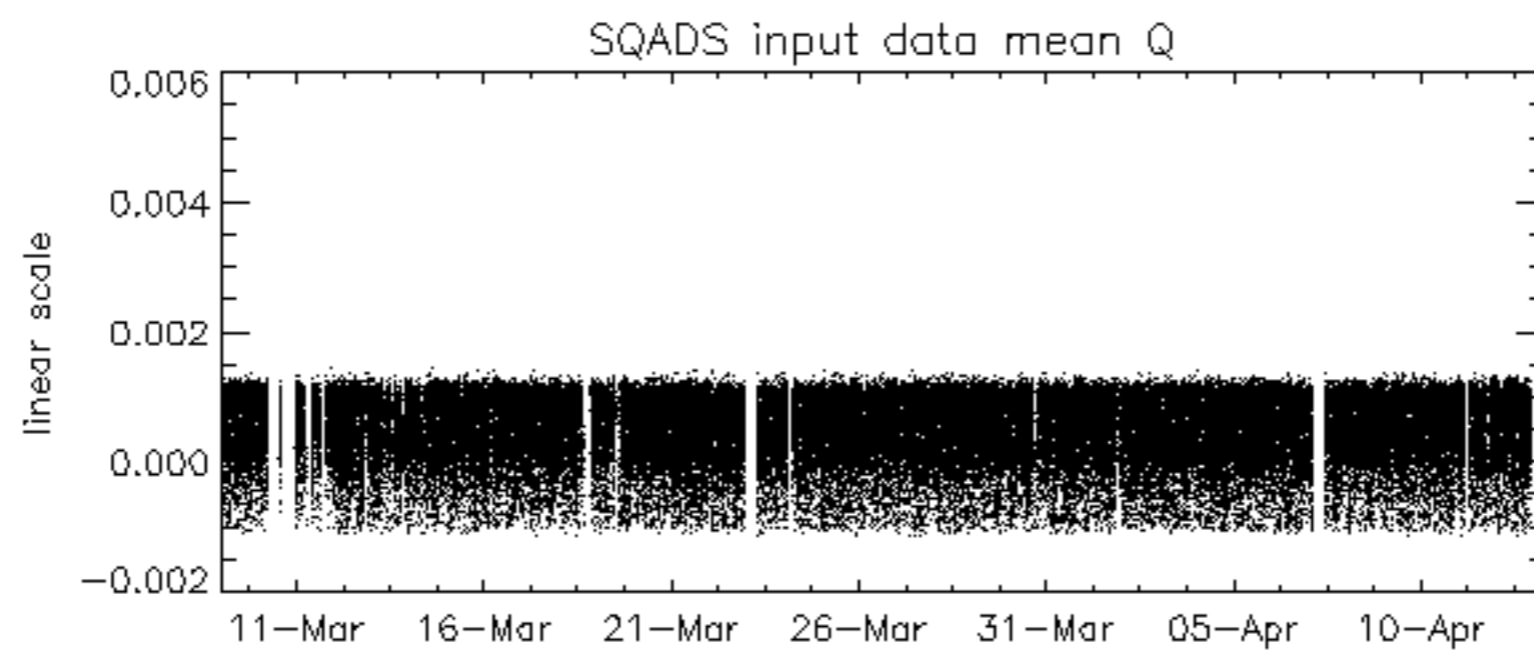
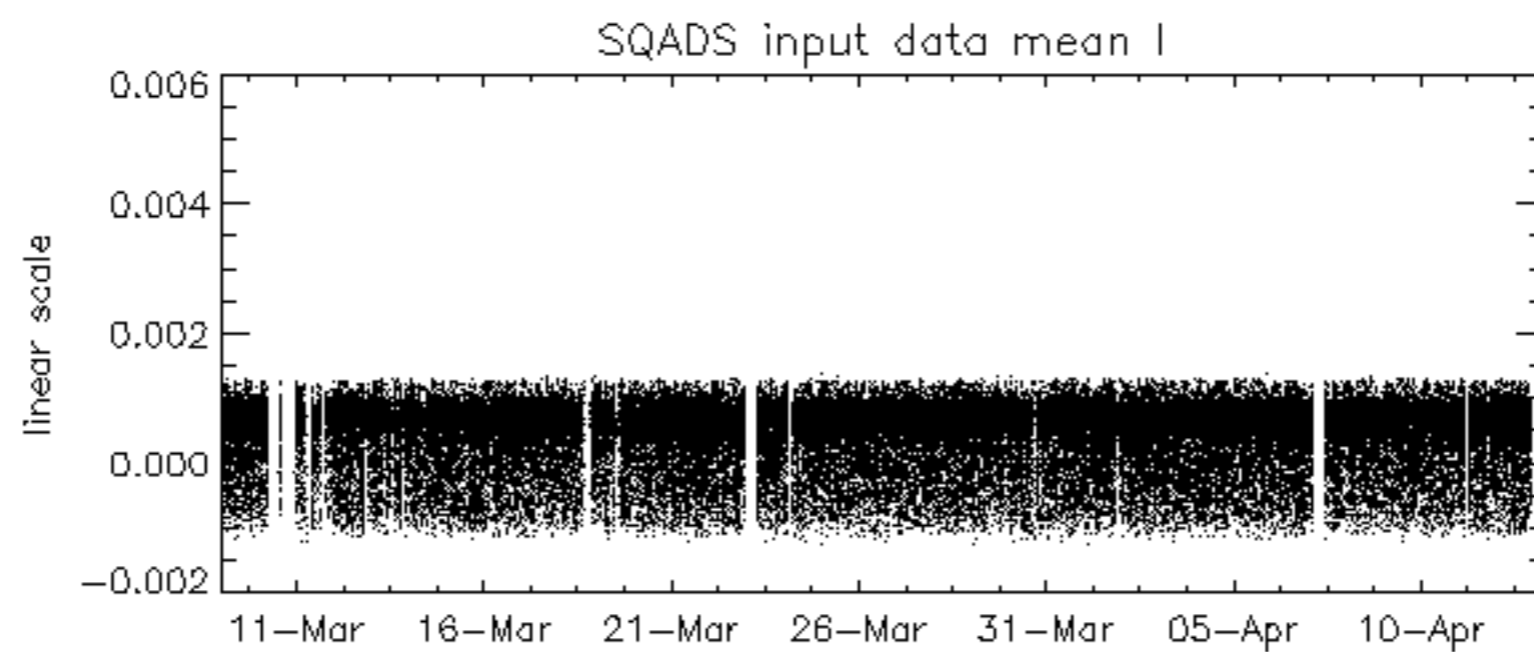
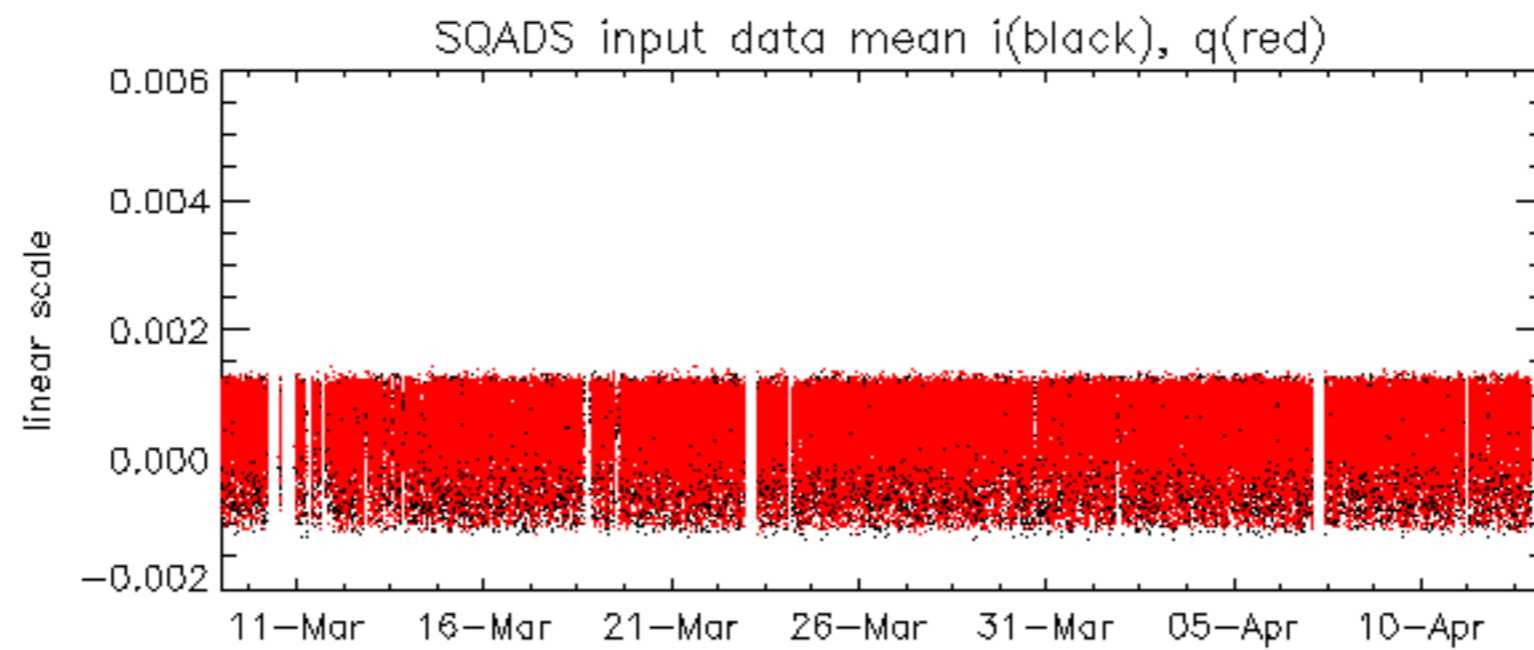


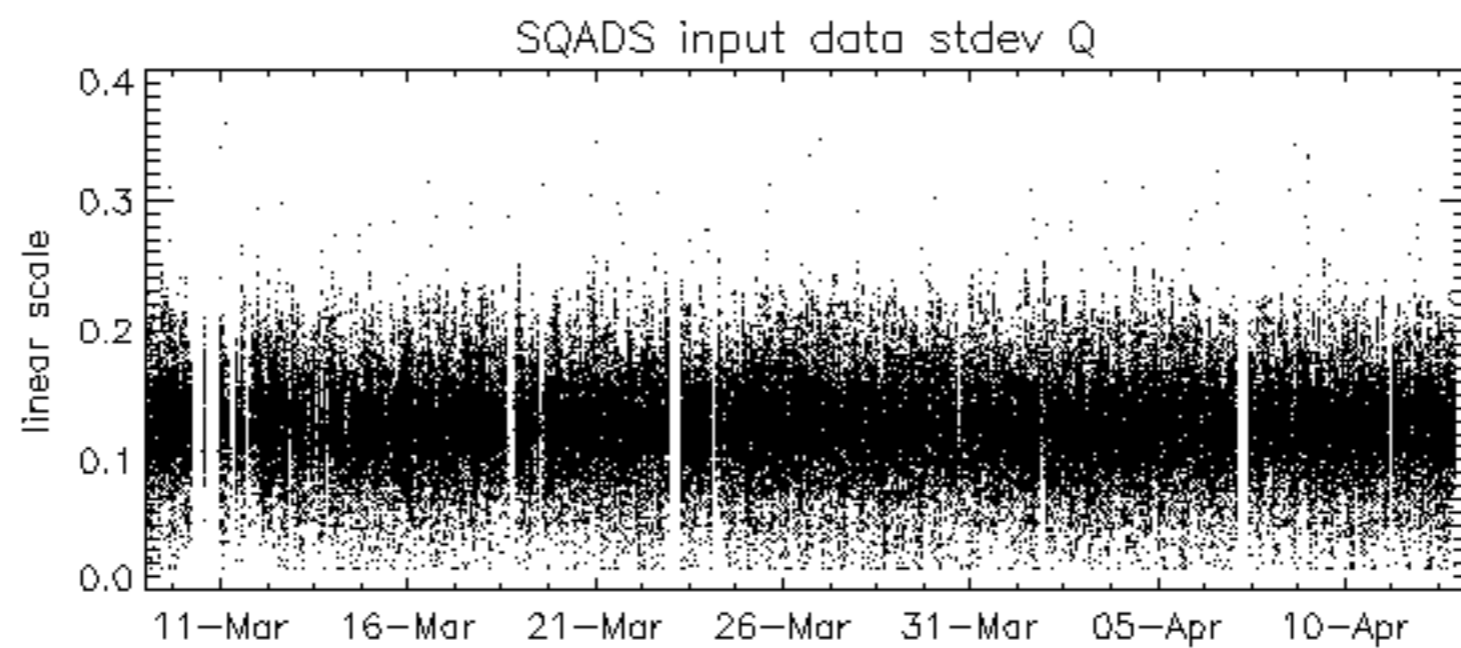
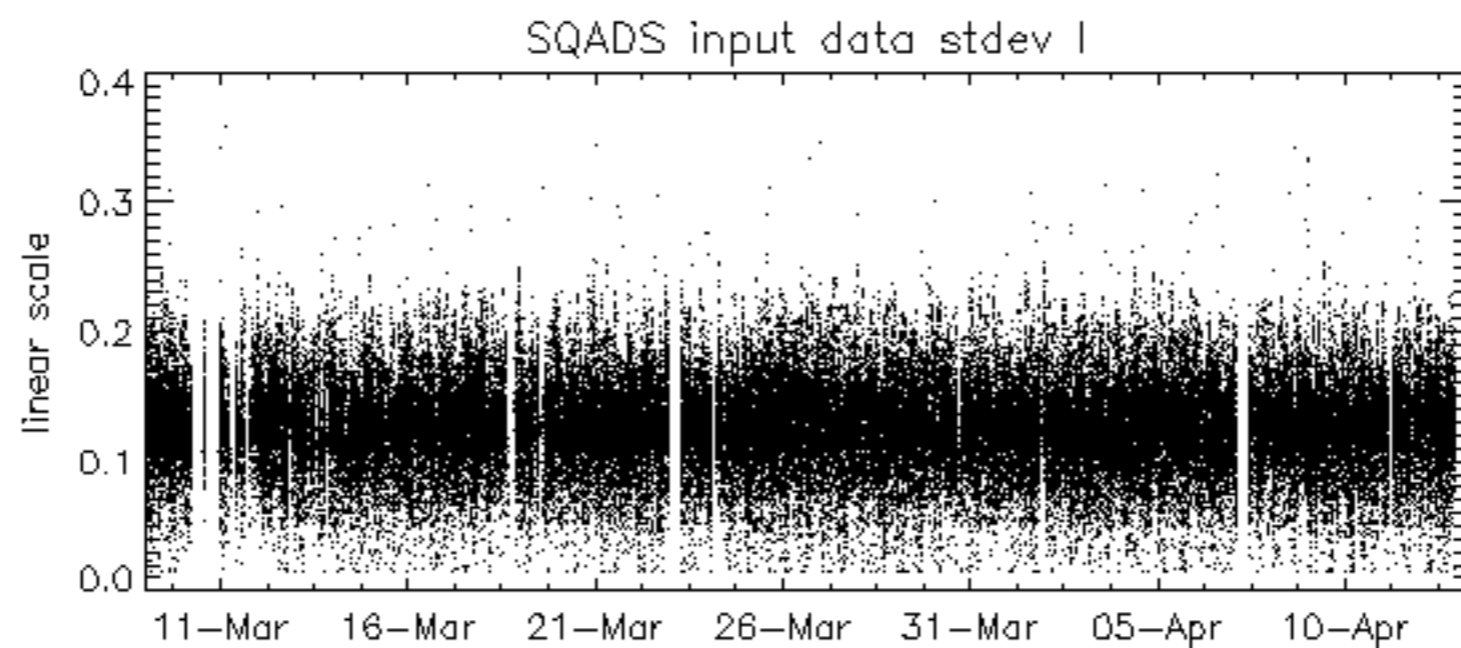
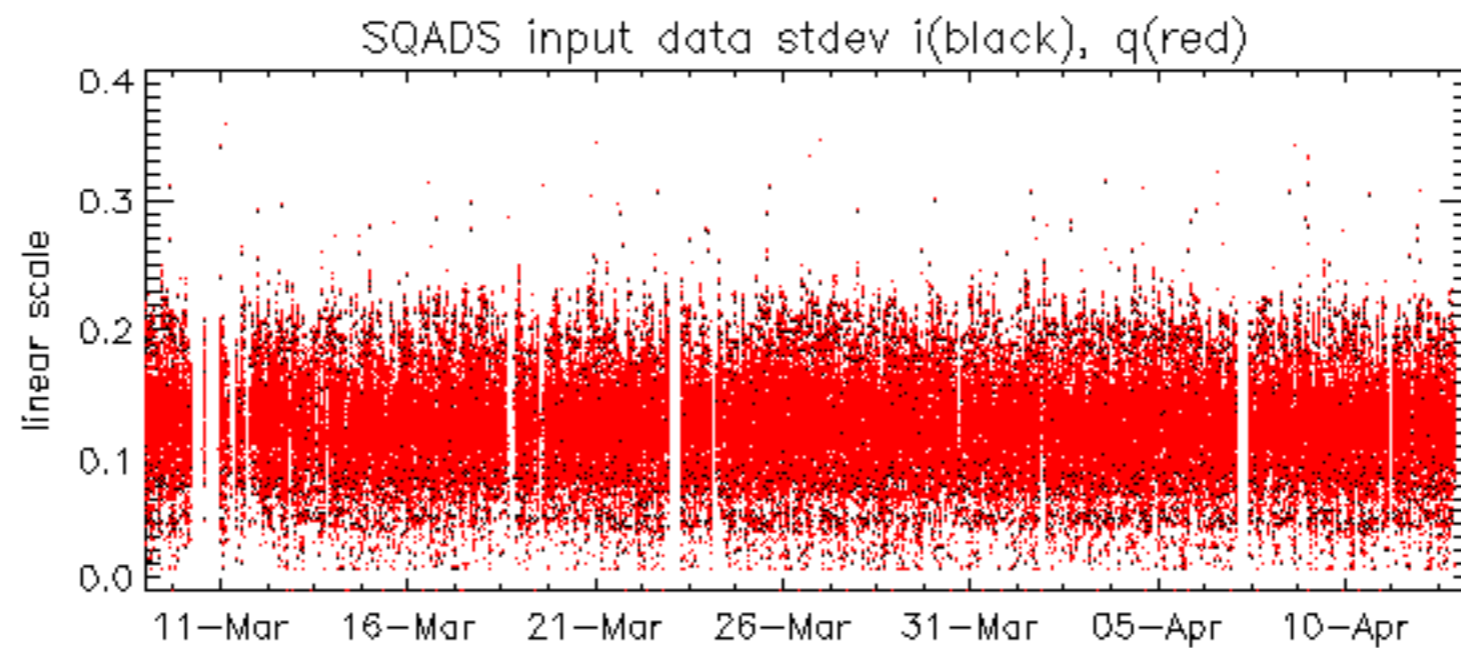
